On behalf of the organizing committee and myself, welcome to the 38th Manx GP Rally.

There have been even more changes to the programme this year, so please read carefully the following instructions and any other supplemental or final Parade Instructions.

- All entrants MUST hold a current full motorcycle driving licence and Road Traffic Act (RTA) liabilities insurance. Machines MUST have a current road fund licence displayed and meet all Road Traffic Act requirements
- The Festival of Jurby is a separate event run under its own regulations and requiring a separate entry form and fee. These must be returned with your completed rally entry pack
- Rally entrants will be able to choose not to take part in the Closed Road Parades. Those wishing not to Parade will pay a reduced entry fee (see Entry Form). Entrants MUST decide at the time of entering the Rally if they wish to Parade, as changes will not be possible once entry packs have been sent to entrants
- PLEASE NOTE There is not an option to Parade only
- To be eligible for any award an entrant must use the same bike throughout that day's event
- Entrants under 18 years old, motorcycle sidecar combinations, other three-wheeled machines and passengers on solo machines are NOT permitted to take part in the Closed Road Parades. All entrants parading who have passengers must make their OWN arrangements for transporting their passengers to the finish as organisers are unable to transport any entrant's passengers
- Closing date for names of entrants to be included in the programme is July 31st 2010
- Closing date for Rally entry is August 10th 2010. Late entries will be accepted after this date [space permitting] but will be subject to a late entry fee of £10.00 per person
- The Festival of Jurby will allow motorcycle combinations and other three wheeled machines
- For the Jurby and closed roads events you must possess a full motorcycle driving licence or an ACU or equivalent licence. You must bring your driving licence for proof of identity when you sign on for either of these events. All other events are held on open public roads where the normal rules of law prevail
- Riders over the age of 70 are permitted to take part in the Closed Roads Parade only after producing a fitness certificate signed by their doctor stating they are fit to do so. This certificate must be produced at the time of signing on for the Parade(s)
- No entrant will be allowed to take part in any of the Parades wearing a pudding basin helmet. There are other additional requirements for clothing, see Parade Instructions for full details, these will be included in the final instructions
- All entrants will be required to show their VMCC Membership Card and to SIGN ON for each event. ONE DAY MEMBERSHIP is acceptable, please ask for details
- The riding number is to be displayed so as to be easily seen from the front of the machine during all events. Please pay particular attention to this requirement if you have changed machines

Should you be unfortunate and break down whilst on one of the events, stay with your machine on route and in a conspicuous place. There will be a recovery vehicle circulating the route to give assistance.
